


Oak Class at the Hay Festival

Keystage 1 – Reception, Y1 & Y2

(Acorns & Y2 from Beech Class)

Afternoon session (1.15 - 3pm)

Keystage 2 – Y3, Y4, Y5 & Y6

(Y3 from Beech Class & Oak Class)

- Children to come to school wearing their Forest Schools clothes and footwear
- Children to bring school uniform & footwear in to school in a bag or rucksack to change into following the session
- Children to wear school uniform to school
- Forest Schools clothes & footwear to be brought in to school in a bag or rucksack to change into prior to the session.
- ALL children will need a sunhat/suncap
- **Suncream** should be applied (before school) on sunny days as the children will be outside all morning or afternoon. KS2 children to bring suncream to apply if required before the afternoon session.
