This week...

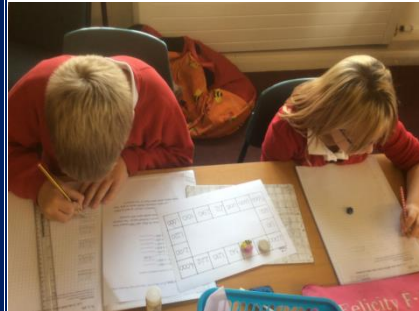
