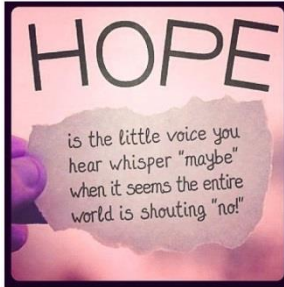

	SPaG & English	Maths
<b>Acorn Class</b>	We have been revising the addition of 's' and 'es' on plural words.	We have been looking at our number bonds to 20.
<b>Beech Class</b>	We have been adding the suffix -y to nouns and verbs to make adjectives. In SPaG we have been looking at how we ensure our sentences are grammatically correct by using the correct verb. We have been busy writing setting descriptions for our 'Hot' task and a 'Cold' task story opening for a short animation called 'Something Fishy'.	We have been using <> and =; practising our timetables and counting on in U, TU and multiplies of 10 (X3), ensuring we keep our place value as we record our calculations)
<b>Oak Class</b>	We have been writing and performing (to camera) our own autobiographical poems.	We have been consolidating our division and multiplication knowledge by looking at square & prime numbers and the meaning of 'square root'.
