Big congratulations to Abi, Oscar and Isaac who took part in the City of Hereford Swimming Club Gala on Saturday – swimming in the 25m Freestyle and 25m Butterfly races. 325 children from 24 primary schools took part. They did superbly and came away triumphant, earning Llangrove 3<sup>rd</sup> place in the Small Schools category.

There was great excitement on Thursday morning when a mystery '**Bird Man**' flew over school, circling the field a number of times before throwing a message in a bag to **Oak Class**, who were watching below.

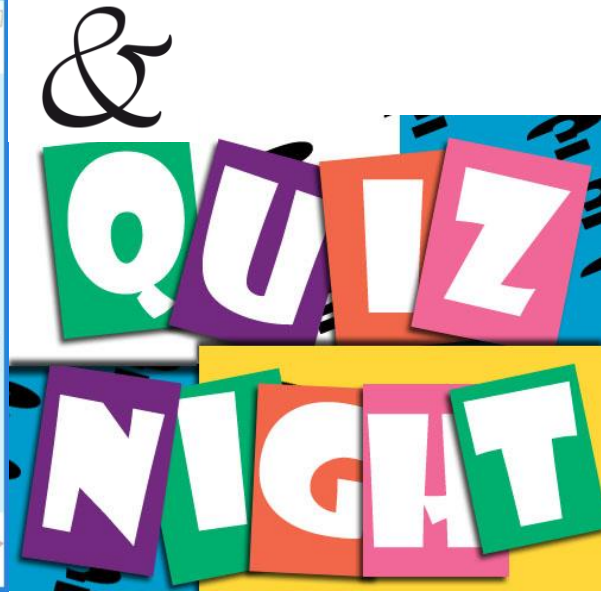
1. Using your device (iPad, iPhone, smart pad, tablet or android phone), visit the relevant marketplace for your product (Apple Store or Google Play).
2. Search for '**OurSchoolsApp**' and download the app.
3. Once downloaded, use the search bar within the app, under settings, and enter the postcode or the name of the school.
4. Hit the search button.
5. Once you see the school name displayed, just touch the screen on the school name.
6. Confirm your choice by pressing 'OK'.
7. You will now be presented with the correct app for your chosen school which contains news, information, calendar events, contacts and any other relevant details.
