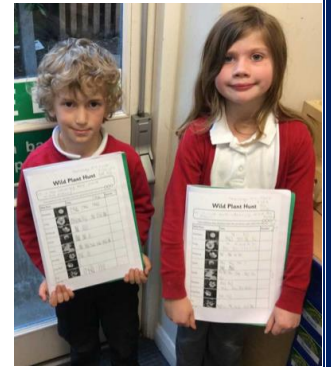

Acorn Class		The children have started learning our new story of 'The Gingerbread Man'. We have put actions to the story to learn it off by heart and created story maps. Reception have been creating speech bubbles of what the characters say in the story.	In maths, our focus has been capacity. We have been exploring capacity through non-standard units, estimating different capacities and ordering different capacities. The children have been labelling different capacities using vocabulary such as full, empty and half full.
Beech Class		The children have completed their 'The Coming of the Iron Man' poems using similes to describe. They have used the text to identify how the author has described the main character. They've used these to create 'Wanted' posters. Both Year groups have also completed a 'cold' SPaG task and identified targets for the class and themselves.	Both Year groups have also completed a 'cold' maths task which identified targets for the class and themselves. The children work has focused on properties of 2D shapes, which they have used to create their own Iron Men.
Oak Class		Year 4 & 5 have been learning the suspense story 'Zelda Claw' by Pie Corbett. They have identified similes, metaphors and alliteration. They have produced story maps to support their recall. All Year groups have also completed a 'cold' SPaG task, which identified targets for the class and themselves.	All Year groups in Oak Class have completed a 'cold' maths task which and identified targets for the class. The children have been focusing on data handling including Y6 creating pie charts.
