Acorn Class		We have been creating our own story of 'The Gingerbread Man'. The children have been substituting the characters to make their own story, thinking of super adjectives to describe them. We have also focused on the use of exclamation marks.	We have revisited length and height. The children have been using rulers and metre sticks to measure: estimating different lengths and solving problems involving length and height. We have focused on our reasoning skills, explaining our answers. Reception have been focusing on number work. They have been filling in numbers in missing number sequences.
Beech Class		The children have been learning their new T4W instructional texts: How to Trap a Stone Giant. We have drawn a storyboard to help us 'act' out the story.	We have been rounding to the nearest 10 (and 100) as well as using formal written methods to add 2 & 3 digit numbers.
Oak Class		The new word of the week is 'peculiar' and the class have been having fun producing sentences containing it. After finishing their innovated Zelda Claw story, the class are now working on characterisation. The emphasis has been on movement, appearance, sound and smell.	This week we have completed our work on fractions and decimals and percentages. We are now revisiting multiplication using different written methods.
