Reading

- Your child has brought home a reading packet containing a reading book and a reading record. Please read with your child regularly and write in the record so we can see when they have read.
- Book bags with their reading book and record to be brought to school every day.
- Books will be changed twice a week on a Monday and Thursday.

Blending

- Blending Books with new sounds will be coming home next week. Blending is really important to their reading and writing development. Please initial at the bottom of the page to let us know you have blended with them.

Snacks & Water

- Fruit is provided daily to the children at break time.
- Children can bring a **healthy** snack to eat at break time if they wish.
- If you have signed your child up for the milk scheme then milk is given to them daily.
- Children are more than welcome to bring a water bottle to school. Please ensure this is clearly labelled with their name.

Uniform

- Please can all children have a coat with them in school daily.
- Girls with long hair need to have it tied back.
- Please can you ensure that all uniform is named.

Tapestry

- Tapestry will be continued to be used throughout year 1.
- Tapestry is a fantastic way of you being able to see what your child is doing at school. It is updated regularly. Feel welcome to comment on any pictures and add any pictures of your own to your child's Tapestry journal.
- If you are having any issues accessing Tapestry please see Miss Gee.

PE Kit

- PE in Acorn Class is on a Wednesday. Please ensure their kit is in school all week, clearly labelled. We will send PE kits home at the end of every half term to be washed.
- Girls with long hair need to ensure hair is tied up on a PE day.
