English

In English we will be exploring traditional tales such as 'Billy Goats Gruff' and 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'; developing our descriptive and imaginative writing. We will be using the 'Talk for Writing' approach (T4W) to develop our skills as writers. They will also have a go at creating an advert for Grandma's house in Little Red Riding Hood.

History

Our topic for History is going to be kings and queens. The children will be learning about the royal family.

PSHE

Initially, we will be focussing on class rules and routines. We will also discuss who we are and what makes us special in our school community.

Mathematics

In maths the children will develop their understanding of place value. They will also explore key areas in maths such as number, shape, and addition and subtraction.

Number and reasoning skills will continue to be developed through our mathematics lessons.

Science

In Science we will be looking at Plants.

We will be identifying and naming a
variety of plants, looking at their
structure and investigating what a
plant needs to grow.

We will also be exploring seasonal changes, identifying the features of each season.

Music

The children will be exploring sound using body percussion and instruments. They will be introduced to key musical terms such as rhythm and beat. They will also be listening and giving opinions on live music.

Computing

In computing we will be learning to save to network and login and conduct simple searches on the web.

They will also be using apps to support their learning in class.

Physical Education

In PE, we will cover basic movement skills, including running, jumping, throwing, and catching, as well as developing balance, agility, and co-ordination. We will begin to apply these in a range of activities and games.

Art and Design

Children will be exploring colour. We will be using a variety of natural materials to create pictures. We will also be designing, making, and evaluating our own moving pictures to go alongside our stories we create.

Religious Education

During this term, the children will be learning about the traditional celebrations of Harvest and Christmas. We will also be exploring the Christian faith focussing on God.
