

Acorn Class		<p>Year 1 have innovated the story of the 'Billy Goats Gruff' and wrote their own version! They are fantastic stories- well done!</p> <p>Reception have continued with their sounds and have been learning m and d practising with their letter formation. The children have also had great fun acting out the story of the 'Billy Goats Gruff' with their fantastic troll voices.</p>	<p>In maths Year 1 have focussed on the composition of the numbers 6-10. We have been using tens frames, number lines, cubes and part whole models to represent them. They have also been exploring odd and even numbers.</p> <p>Reception have continued to explore the numbers 1-10. We have been representing them in different ways and placing them on the number line in the correct order.</p>
Beech Class		<p>We have continued to use adjectives and nouns to describe characters. We have planned our adaptations of the wishing tale 'The Magic Paintbrush' and are looking forward to writing them.</p>	<p>We have been focusing on: odd and even numbers, counting in 10s and rounding 2 &amp; 3 digit numbers to the nearest 10</p> <p>We've learnt a rounding rhyme to help us remember the method:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1, 2, 3, 4 round DOWN to the ten before, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 round UP to the next ten on the numberline</p>
Oak Class		<p>After completing the editing phase of our writing, we have written our final draft of our mystery finding tale. These have been uploaded to SeeSaw for your reading pleasure ☺</p>	<p>We have used our knowledge of rounding to estimate mental additions.</p> <p>We are now recapping on our knowledge of the formal method addition – ensuring we remember to exchange values.</p>
