Acorn Class will be starting Forest Schools on the first Monday of the new term.

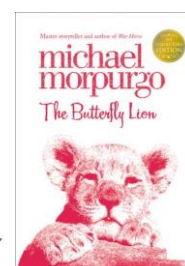
