- The school council have planned a **Danceathon** to take place every hour throughout the school day.







### PTFA 'Sports Relief' Disco .....

	Class Story	English & SPaG	Maths
Acorn Class		Year 1 have been exploring instructions. They have learnt a set of instructions, explored time phrases and used imperative verbs. Reception have been using adjectives to describe the wolf in the story of Mr Wolf's Pancakes.	This week our maths focus has been measurement. The children have been using language such as taller, longer, shorter and smaller to describe different measurements. They have also been ordering objects from shortest to longest and longest to shortest. Year 1 have started to use non-standard units to explore different lengths.
Beech Class		The children have been writing their own dinosaur stories with carnivores and herbivores, using descriptive language to describe the characters and the settings.	Our maths focus has been measurement. We have measured using mm, cms and metres. Year 3 also converted measurements into mm, cms, m by x 10 or 100. We also ordered dinosaurs from shortest to longest. We learnt/recalled the following length facts: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 10 millimetres = 1 centimetres</li> <li>• 100 centimetres = 1 metre</li> <li>• 1000 metres = 1 kilometre</li> </ul> Please remind the children of these facts if you are measuring at home.
Oak Class		Oak Class have reflected on past events that have helped shape their lives using 'if...if...if...then' type sentences.	This week we have practised using bar models to calculate fractions of amounts. e.g. If $\frac{1}{5}$ of a pack of biscuits is 7 how many are in a whole packet?
		This half term we have introduced 'Story Time' on Tuesday afternoons. Pupils from Oak Class will be taking turns to choose & read a book to pupils in Acorn & Beech Class
