Next Friday, to celebrate and fund raise for Comic Relief, we would like the children to come to school in red clothes (with a donation of £1 or more).



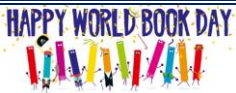
Choose and Tell a Joke...
