Hygiene

- o Children have designated toilet cubicles to use, which are not shared with pupils outside of Oak Class. These are cleaned throughout the day.
- o Handwashing is mandatory for all staff and pupils whenever returning to the classroom after breaks.
- o Tables are cleaned regularly throughout the day.

Reading

- Your child is to bring a reading book with them to school, along with their Reading Log every day. Upon finishing the book, it will be placed in a quarantine box for two days prior to it being returned to the library for other children to select.
- o Please can you sign your child's Reading Log whenever you hear them read. Please note down any 'tricky words' or misconceptions that your child may have about the plot.

Spellings

- o Spelling tests are **every Monday**. Your child will note down their score in their spelling log along with any words they still struggled to spell. The list of new spellings will be taken down by your child in their spelling book the same day.
- o In the front of your child's spelling log you will find statutory National Curriculum spelling lists. The highlighted words are the words that your child can currently spell unaided. Please practise the unknown spellings alongside their weekly spelling list.

Snacks & Water

- Tuck Shop is not currently available at school. Please provide your child with a healthy snack for break time.
- o Daily milk is available to purchase through 'Cool Milk'. If you are interested please contact Mrs Townson for further details.
- Named water bottles can be brought into class to be drunk throughout the day water only please. <u>These water bottles must be brought home and washed daily.</u>

<u>Stationery</u>

All required stationery is available for the children at school. However, should your child wish
to bring in their own stationery from home, then please can this be in a small pencil case
that will fit on your child's table. Children are prohibited from sharing their stationery at
school.

Times Tables

- Practising times tables is an integral part of your child's weekly homework. They will be tested (Ladder Club) every Friday with any achievements noted on the weekly newsletter.
- 'TT Rockstars' is available as a learning tool to use at home. It is accessible on all electronic devices that have internet connection. Progress is celebrated in class on a designated 'TT Rockstars' board.

PE Kit

o Oak Class' PE day is **Tuesday**. Children should come to school in their PE kit and a coat. They will then wear their PE kit home ready for washing.
