Mathematics

The key areas this term are:

Y4/5: Geometry, Time, Fractions and decimals

Y6: Ratio & proportion

The children's number skills will continue to be developed through our daily times table sessions.

Science

In Science we will be looking at 'habitats'. Classifying groups of animals, completing food chains, food webs and examining the different habitats that they are adapted to survive the best within.

Religious Education

We will be exploring the question 'Why do Hindus want to be good?' – examining the terms kharma, samsara, moksha & dharma.

Physical Education

In PE we will be improving our striking skills, incorporating these into rounders. We will also be marking National Sports Week with a week of visitors and activities across several different sports.
