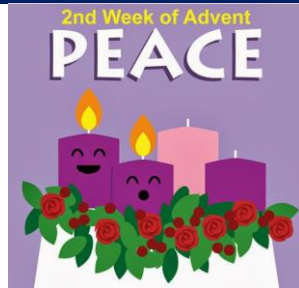

Thank you for your donations – the children were proud to 'present' them to you in the hall this week.

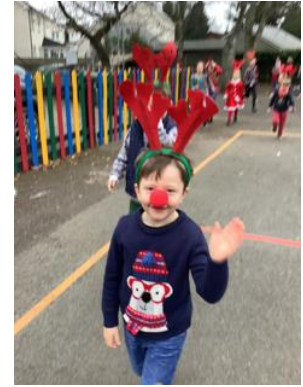


A total of £321 was raised – all the money raised goes directly to benefit the children as it will be shared between the three classes.
