

English

In English we will be exploring traditional tales such as 'The Three Little Pigs' developing our descriptive and imaginative writing. We will be using the 'Talk for Writing' approach (T4W) to develop our skills as writers. They will also have a go at writing a set of instructions on how to make a house for one of the Three Little Pigs.

Mathematics

In maths the children will develop their understanding of place value. They will be exploring their understanding of number through developing number sense using practical resources to support this.

They will also be developing their understanding of both 2D and 3D shapes.

Science

In Science we will be looking at materials. We will be exploring a range of different materials, naming everyday materials, exploring the properties of everyday materials, and experimenting using different materials.



Religious Education

In RE we will be exploring 'What do Christians believe God is like?' and 'Who is a Muslim and how do they live?'

Computing

The children will be developing their understanding of technology and how it can help us. We will also be exploring using a mouse, and a keyboard to help us word process and create our own digital paintings.

History

In history we will be developing key historical skills such as chronology and using sources to find out about life in the past. We will be exploring what houses were like in the past and comparing them to the houses we see today.

Geography

In Geography we will be exploring where I live, learning our addresses. We will be naming the four countries of the UK and locating them on the map. We will be exploring the main towns and cities in the UK.

PSHE

Throughout this term we will be looking at 'Being me in my world'. We will be developing our understanding of how we belong to our class, how we can make good friends and how we can create a good learning environment.

Art and Design & DT

In Art we will be exploring the primary colours and have a go at mixing primary colours. We will use our primary colours to create a repeating pattern.

In DT we will be designing, making, and evaluating our own home.

Physical Education

In PE we will cover basic movement skills, including: running, jumping, throwing and catching, as well as developing balance, agility and co-ordination. We will begin to apply these in a range of activities and games.

Music

The children will be using their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs. They will also be listening to live music and exploring pulse and rhythm.

Phonics

Reception will begin to learn their phase 2 sounds.

Year 1 will begin to learn their phase 5 sounds.
