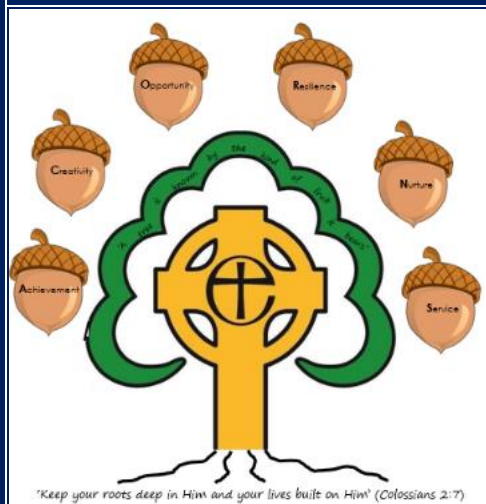



	Class Story	English & SPaG	Maths
Acorn Class		<p>We have started our new story of 'The Three Little Pigs'. The children had great fun with our 'hook', making a new house for one of the three pigs out of marshmallows and spaghetti- we even did the huff and the puff test! After that we learnt the story using actions to help us and created our own story maps.</p> <p>In SPaG we have been focusing in on our sentence writing using conjunctions to join our ideas together.</p>	<p>Year 1 have been using their knowledge of simple number facts and teen numbers to help them with their addition and subtraction to 20. We have been spotting the number facts in the number sentences to help us. Reception have been exploring teen numbers using 'ten and a bit'. We have been partitioning and ordering our teen numbers with the help of the Numberblocks!</p>

<p><b>Beech Class</b></p>		<p>We have continued to look at explanation texts and are beginning to plan out our own text 'Why are dinosaurs extinct?' We have discussed reasons for them becoming extinct considering the best conjunctions to use when joining together two sentences.</p>	<p>We have been finding fractions of amounts. Year 2 have used 'sharing' cubes to find <math>\frac{1}{2}</math> of amounts. Year 3 have used timetable &amp; division facts to find <math>\frac{1}{4}</math>, <math>\frac{1}{2}</math>, <math>\frac{1}{3}</math>, <math>\frac{1}{5}</math> of amounts. e.g. <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> of 24 is 6 because <math>24 \div 4 = 6</math>. In Place value we have been recapping counting forwards and backwards in 1s and 10s. We have also started measurements – focusing initially on length.</p>
<p><b>Oak Class</b></p>		<p>We have been learning all about Chinese Sasquatches from our new non-chronological report. We have focused on learning the text through visual aids to help us recall key sentence openers and specific vocabulary. Can your child remember the text?</p>	<p>We have focused on multiplication facts – playing lots of games to consolidate our knowledge of multiplication and division facts. We have also rehearsed our knowledge of the terms factor and multiple.</p>


