# **Reading**

- Your child is to bring a reading book with them to school, along with their Reading Log every day.
- Please read with your child every day. Sign your child's Reading Log and note down any 'tricky words' or misconceptions that your child may have about the plot.
   Completing books earns you a bookworm on our wall!
- Encourage your child to read a range of texts from a variety of sources. E.g. newspapers, magazine articles, non-fiction books.

## **Spellings**

 Spelling tests are every Monday. Your child has a spelling folder that contains their spellings to be practised. There is also a homework sheet that needs to be completed for Monday morning.

At the back of the folder will be a list of the Year 5/6 statutory spellings from The National Curriculum. Highlighted words are words your child spelt correctly at the beginning of the year. Please look at the remainder of the words. Pupils will be retested on these throughout the school year.

All work completed should be in the children's best handwriting.

## **Times Tables**

- o Practising times tables is an integral part of your child's weekly homework. The pupils take part in daily times table practice as part of their maths lesson.
- o 'TT Rockstars' is available as a learning tool to use at home. It is accessible on all electronic devices that have an internet connection. The times table focus in class will be replicated with the times table allocated on TT Rockstars.

#### **PE Kit**

Oak Class' PE day is Thursday. <u>Children should come to school in their full school PE</u>
 <u>kit as well as coat for break times</u>. School PE kit is a white t-shirt, red shorts and white
 socks. A navy-blue school hooded sweater may also be worn. No branded jumpers
 please. The children will wear their PE kit home ready for washing.
