Physical Education:

In Autumn 1, we will be doing netball. We are looking to improve our consistency and accuracy in a game setting.

In Autumn 2, we will be doing gymnastics with a focus on creativity and movement.

Science:

In Autumn 1, we will be exploring animals including humans. We are focusing on food chains and the relationship between all animals. We are also looking into changes throughout a human lifecycle.

In Autumn 2, we will be exploring animals and their habitats.

Art and DT:

In Autumn 2, we will be creating river inspired artwork by taking inspiration from important artists throughout history. We will be discussing their techniques and using them in our own pieces.

Religious Education:

In RE, we will exploring what it is like to be a Muslim in Britain today.

In Autumn 2, we will be looking at the importance of festivals and family to Jewish people.

RAGING RIVERS AND MOUNTAINS

Enrichment Activity:

As part of our topic, we will look at the journey of a river and use different materials to build a class river.

English:

In English, we will be writing a Journey
Tale. This is where our main character
travels to a destination but faces a problem!
We will be doing weekly SPaG sessions so
that we can develop our understanding. We
will also be writing river poetry.

Mathematics:

In Autumn 1, Year 5 will be exploring decimal fractions and money. In Autumn 2, we will exploring negative numbers and short multiplication/division.

Year 4 will be reviewing column addition and subtraction whilst exploring numbers to 10,000. In Autumn 2, we will look into perimeter and our 3, 6 and 9 times tables.

Geography and History:

In Autumn 1, we will be focusing on the difference between the UK, Great Britain and the British Isles. We will also be using atlases to locate important rivers and mountain ranges from around the world. Additionally, we will be plotting the journey of a river and finding out about its course.
