Before Easter, Oak Class set up a photosynthesis investigation.












The May Fayre is our biggest fundraising event of the year. 25% of the event's profits come directly to the school.

The PTFA are delighted to say that profits from our upcoming events will be going towards improving the school garden area, particularly in the purchase of new raised beds with better accessibility for the children.






Frozen Fridays...


