

English

In English we will be exploring the stories such as 'Dear Zoo', 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff' and 'Tyrannosaurus Drip'; developing the structure, description and narrative of our writing. We will be using the 'Talk for Writing' approach (T4W) to develop our skills as writers. They will develop their knowledge of a range of interesting varied texts including recount writing and poetry.

Mathematics

The children will develop their mastery of maths through exploration of key areas in maths such as number and place value, addition, subtraction, counting in 2's, 5's and 10's and money.

Number and reasoning skills will continue to be developed through our maths lessons.

Science

In Science we will be looking at animals including humans. We will be identifying and naming a variety of common animals including, fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals, identifying and naming a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores and name, drawing and labelling the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense.



Religious Education

In RE we will be exploring 'What is the 'good news' Christians believe Jesus brings? We will also be learning why does Easter matter to Christians?

Geography

In Geography we will be exploring the map of the world finding out where different animals come from and key facts about that country.

Computing

The children will be continuing to learning about the common uses of ICT. We will be having a go at programming this term using BeeBots and programmes such as scratch. They will also be using apps to support their learning in class.

Art and Design

In Art we will be focusing on printing. We will be using a variety of natural materials to create a range of different prints. We will also be taking inspiration from famous artists such as Andy Warhol. We will also be designing, making and evaluating our own moving animal toy!

Physical Education

In PE we will be focussing on dance and gymnastics this term. We will be finding out different ways of moving and putting our moves into a sequence and having a go at performing them to our peers.



Music

The children will be naming and using a range of instruments to perform. They will also be giving their opinions on pieces of music.
