SCIENCE

Our focus will be 'Forces' - we will be learning about how different forces act on objects. We aim to design our own parachutes.

FRENCH

In French, we will be learning how to say conversational terms. We are also learning how to talk about different sports.

GEOGRAPHY

We will be investigating rivers and mountains. During geography, we will be researching the course of a river and using atlases to identify the world's most famous rivers and mountain ranges.

MATHEMATICS

The key areas this half-term are: place value, column addition and subtraction and problem solving.

The children's number and reasoning skills will continue to develop during our daily 'basic skills' and weekly times tables sessions.

ENGLISH

During English, we will start the term by writing our own free verse river poems.

Our Talk4Writing focus will be on Journey Tales. Using the model text 'Thog's Journey' to help us to structure our own fictional tales.

Specific grammar objectives will also be taught during weekly grammar sessions.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

In Religious Education, we will be using different biblical texts to learn how and why Christians believe God is loving and holy.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

In PE we will be doing hockey. We will work on our communication skills, passing, dribbling and developing tactics.

ART

We will be taking Monet and the Impressionists as our inspiration and creating water inspired artwork. We will do two versions of the same picture and decide what material is the most effective to work on.
