## English

In English we will be exploring traditional tales such as 'The Gingerbread Man' and 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears':
developing our descriptive and imaginative writing. We will be using the 'Talk for Writing' approach (T4W) to develop our skills as writers. They will also have a go at creating an advert for Grandma's house in Little Red Riding Hood.

#### **Mathematics**

In maths the children will develop their understanding of place value. They will be exploring their understanding of number through developing number sense using practical resources to support this.

They will also be developing their understanding of both 2D and 3D shapes.

#### Science

In Science we will be looking at materials. We will be exploring a range of different materials, naming everyday materials, exploring the properties of everyday materials, and experimenting using different materials.

# Computing

During this term the children will be

The children will be developing their understanding of technology and how it can help us. We will also be exploring using a mouse, and a keyboard to help us word process and create our own digital paintings.







#### History
