Reading

- Your child is to bring a reading book with them to school, along with their Reading Log every day.
- Please read with your child every day. Sign your child's Reading Log and note down any 'tricky words' or misconceptions that your child may have about the plot.
 Colour in a square in the reading log to help collate team points!
- Encourage your child to read a range of texts from a variety of sources. E.g. newspapers, magazine articles, non-fiction books.

Spellings

 Spelling tests are every Monday. Your child has a spelling folder than contains their spellings to be practised. There is also a homework sheet that needs to be completed.

All work completed should be in the children's best handwriting.

Times Tables

- Practising times tables is an integral part of your child's weekly homework. They will be tested (Ladder Club) every Monday with any achievements noted on the weekly newsletter.

PE Kit
