

English

In English we will be exploring the story of 'Supertato' and 'Elliot, midnight superhero'; developing our descriptive writing, especially setting and openings. We will be using the 'Talk for Writing' approach (T4W) to develop our skills as writers. They will develop their knowledge of a range of interesting varied texts including instructions and poetry.

Mathematics

In maths the children will develop their understanding of place value. They will also explore key areas in maths such as addition and subtraction, number bonds and measure.

Reasoning skills will continue to be developed through our daily mastering number sessions.

Science

In Science we will be looking at animals including humans. We will be naming the different parts of the human body and exploring our 5 senses. We will also be naming a variety of common animals, grouping them and describing the structure of these common animals.

Art and Design

In art we will continue to develop our sketching skills, knowledge of different artists and use of a range of materials. In DT we will be designing, making and evaluating our very own superhero hand puppet.

History

In History we will be looking at real life superheroes including Florence Nightingale and Christopher Columbus. We will be looking at the main events in their life and sequence them. We will also look at the difference between past and present.

Computing

The children will be learning about how to use the computer and the internet safely. They will also be using apps to support their learning in class.

Music

In music we will be exploring sounds. We will be exploring how sounds can be produced by our voices and different instruments.

In PE we will be focussing on dance and gymnastics, finding out different ways of moving and putting our moves into a sequence.

Geography

During the term we will be developing our map work skills, using keys to support our learning.

PSHE

Throughout this term the children will be looking at their dreams and goals. We will be thinking about what makes us special and how we can overcome obstacles to help us achieve our dreams and goals.
