Physical Education:

In Spring 1, we will be doing dance. This will develop our team work, creativity and how to perform ready for Moving Targets. In Spring 2, we will be doing indoor athletics. This will help us to work on our skills.

Science:

In Spring 1, our focus is sound. We will be exploring how sound travels, how we hear sounds and what happens to sound over a distance. In Spring 2, we will exploring properties of materials.

Art and DT:

In Spring 1, we will be creating self portraits and multimedia artwork of community buildings around Llangrove. We will be experimenting with printing, pastels, sketching techniques and other mediums.

Religious Education:

In RE, we will be learning about how festivals and worship show what is important to Muslims. This topic explores festivals such as Ramadan and also the ways Muslim people dedicate their lives to Allah. Then, we will be looking at what Christians believe Jesus did to "save" people.

Enrichment Activity:

As part of our topic, we will also be exploring the old punishment logs from Llangrove to see what the children used to get up to! We will also be going on a walk.

English:

In English, we will be writing a Suspense Story. This is where our main character will be entering a scary setting in search of something, only to be chased away. This unit will develop our writing for the reader and how we can build suspense.

We will be doing weekly SPaG sessions so that we can develop our understanding.

Mathematics:

In Spring 1, Year 5 will be exploring the concept of volume. Following this, they will be finding factors of numbers. In Spring 2, we will exploring area and scaling and short multiplication and division. Year 4 will be exploring the 3,6,9 times tables and the rules of divisibility. We will follow this in Spring 2 with exploring the 7 times tables and patterns and understanding multiplicative relationships.

Geography and History:

In Spring 2, we will be exploring our local area as part of the local history study. We will carry out research around to develop our measuring skills and understanding of the geographical area.
