

### MFL

In French, we will focus on basic greetings and talking about our families and pets.

### Mathematics

The key areas this term are: Numbers & Place value, Addition & Subtraction; Multiplication & Division. The children's number and reasoning skills will be continue to be developed through our daily timestable practice and Mastering Number sessions.

### Science

The children will be developing practical scientific methods, processes and skills whilst focusing on the topic 'Rocks'. The children will compare and group together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their appearance and simple physical properties. We will find out about how fossils are formed and recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.

### History & Geography

The children will be considering how life changed from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. We will think how historians can know about what life was like in Britain so many years ago before man recorded his thoughts and actions in writing.



## Beech Class Changes: Stone Age to Iron Age

### PSHE

Our focus will be on keeping ourselves healthy, focusing on the importance of varied diets and exercise.

### Art and Design

The children will investigate and create their own cave art and make clay pots. In DT they will investigate levers and linkages.

### Physical Education

In Gymnastics this term, pupils will develop their balances, rolls and sequences on and off apparatus. Dance will focus on developing longer, more complex routines.

### Computing

We will be focusing on information technology – collecting & presenting information, manipulating digital content and completing online searches.



### Religious Education

We will be studying "Good News" and what good news (The Gospel) means for Christians. Year 6 will also be supporting us with all our questions about the Hindu religion.

### Music

Music lessons will focus on how music can communicate different moods and emotions. We will also be singing and learning a song all about petrology and geology!
