

## English

In English we will be exploring the story 'Mr Gumpy's Motor Car', developing our descriptive and imaginative writing with a focus on journey writing. We will be using the 'Talk for Writing' approach (T4W) to develop our skills as writers. We will also be exploring our non-fiction writing skills by creating an information booklet about our favourite transport.

## Geography

In Geography we be exploring the weather in the different countries around the world. We will be looking at different things you would find in hot and cold places and what clothes we would wear when in different countries.

## History

In history we will be exploring how people travel, comparing our travel today to travel in the past. We will also be exploring some local history of our own local area of Llangrove.

## Mathematics

In maths the children will continue develop their understanding of place value to 100. They will also explore key areas in maths such as multiplication, time, measure and positional language. Number and reasoning skills will continue to be developed through our mastering number sessions.

## Science

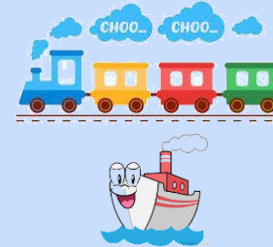
In Science we will be exploring plants. We will be naming a range of common wild and garden plants including trees and describing the basic structure of those plants. We will be finding out what a plant needs to grow and sorting trees into evergreen or deciduous. We will also continue to look at seasonal changes and how the weather changes across the seasons.

## Music

The children will be identifying and describing pitch. They will be using their bodies and instruments to create different pitches. They will also be composing different pitch patterns and representing them using creative graphic notation.

## PSHE

In PHSE we will discuss what it is like being me in my world and how we are changing. We will look at how we learn best, recognise how our views are valued, talk about life cycles and how we have changed since being a baby.

## Physical Education

In PE, we will cover basic movement skills, including running, jumping, throwing, and catching, as well as developing balance, agility, and co-ordination. We will be exploring striking and fielding games and athletics, getting ready for sports day!

## Art and Design

In art we will be exploring how we can create different moods in our art. We will also be creating some 3D art by cutting rolling and coiling materials.

## DT

In DT we will be using axels and wheels to make and design our own car.

## Computing

In computing we will be understanding of the various aspects of using a computer to create and change text. We will familiarise themselves with typing on a keyboard and begin using tools to change the look of our writing, and then they will consider the differences between using a computer and writing on paper to create text.

## Religious Education
