

Physical Education:

In Summer 1, we will be doing rounders. We are looking to improve our teamwork and accuracy in a game setting.

In Autumn 2, we will be going swimming and focusing on athletics in preparation for Sports Day.

Science:

This summer term, we will be exploring electricity. We will be looking at making simple circuits and identifying electrical components. We will also be exploring the different properties of materials.

Art and DT:

In Summer 2, the children will look at creating portraits of Viking faces; focusing on facial expressions and proportions.

Religious Education:

In RE, we will be exploring the features of Gospel texts and asking ourselves 'What would Jesus do?'. In Summer 2, we will be looking at the question 'What does it mean if Christians believe God is holy and loving?'

English:

In English, we will be writing a Finding Tale. Our characters will find treasure but there might be danger lurking.

We will also write an information text about what we find out about Vikings.

We will continue a weekly focus on different areas of SPaG.

Enrichment Activity:

As part of our topic, we will have a day dedicated to living like a Viking! We will play traditional games and look at typical stories.

Mathematics:

In Summer 1, Year 5 will be exploring factors, multiples and primes. They will then move onto fractions. In Summer 2, they will be exploring converting units and angles.

Year 4 will be exploring fractions greater than 1. In Summer 2 they will be moving onto symmetry, time and division with remainders. During Summer 2 term, the Year 4s will be undertaking the Multiplication Screening Check.

Geography and History:

In Summer 1, we will be looking at the different ways that the Vikings changed Britain. We will look at the key events and plot them on a time line. The children will also use atlases to label the main cities that the Vikings raided and settled.
